



UPS & FedEx 2022 Summary of their General Rate Increases.

FedEx Rate increase takes effect January 3rd, 2022, with the following services.

- FedEx Ground and FedEx Home shipments will increase an average of 5.9%.
- FedEx US Export and Import Delivery rates will increase on average of 5.9%.
- FedEx US Express overnight delivery rates will increase an average rate of 5.9%.
- FedEx Freight will also increase about 5.9% for all its customers.
- FedEx Ground Minimum will increase from \$8.76 to \$9.36 or an additional 6.85%.
- FedEx fuel surcharge will also increase effective November 1,2021 by 1.75

FedEx & UPS are increasingly raising rates for small and large packages in order to make more money. They have increased the minimum fees and nearly tripled the cost of larger shipments.

UPS Annual Rate Increase is December 26, 2022, involving the following services.

- UPS Ground Service rates will increase an average of 5.9%.
- UPS Domestic Air Express with next day delivery will increase rates an average of 5.9%.
- UPS US Export and Import rates will also increase an average of 5.9%.
- UPS Surepost will also be impacted by increases of at least 5.9%.
- UPS Ground Minimum will increase from \$8.76 to \$9.36 or an additional 6.85%.

FedEx & UPS have successfully tried in earnest to re-offer the Money Back Guarantee. Most of our clients are now at least being compensated for air FedEx and UPS air services now.

FedEx & UPS Money Makers

There are many ways to increase profits for FedEx and UPS. Recently both carriers increased rates for different zone increasing the rates by each zone. Next, they added to the cost of fuel and began charging an extra dollar for all returns. As if that wasn't enough, next they increased the minimum for ground packages by 6.85%. That increase went from \$8.76 to \$9.36 or \$0.60 for every shipment. FedEx & UPS also can charge everyone additionally for peak season.
